Earth Day 2019 Mount Airy Middle School at the Farm Museum

On May 1, the Bureau of Resource Management hosted a belated Earth Day Celebration for Outdoor School students from Mount Airy Middle. These 65 sixthgrade students rotated through four stations learning about forest conservation and the benefits of planting trees, how to use macroinvertebrates to determine stream health, examples of stormwater best management practices, and how stormwater management ponds address run-off from the surrounding area.

At the end of the day, each group was provided a map depicting the area surrounding the Farm Museum, and students discussed where additional stormwater best management practices might be constructed to provide additional benefits to the watershed.
