	3. <u>Commissioner's Report:</u>
	a. Commissioner Weaver – Concerned about Wreaths Across America in the coming weeks. The
	Governor is speaking today so changes to gathering limits may be announced. Asked how VFWs and
	American Legions are doing. They have been open for business but have needed to close on occasion
	due to coronavirus exposure. They have reserves, income has been down, and fundraisers have had
	to be cancelled. American Legion #200 will be \$29,000 in the red for 2020. Commissioner Weaver will
	look into alternate or reserve funding if available. He encouraged leadership to keep the Board of
	County Commissioners aware of their status.
	b. Commissioner Rothstein – Spoke at Lions Club for Veterans Day, don't stop remembering our
	veterans. He is concerned that many will fall through the cracks, especially now that the weather is
	getting colder. We need to identify not just veteran needs in our county but for everyone.

    - vii. Monthly return on investment, based on known awards is approximately \$937,034 for compensation and pension. Biannual Growth Rate from 1/1/2020 to 7/1/2020 was 13.2% and the Monthly Growth Rate from 10/1/2020 to 11/1/2020 was 0%.
    - viii. Yearly return on investment, based on known awards is approximately \$30,448,000 since inception of the program in October 2013. Yearly Growth Rate for 2020 is 38%.
    - ix. It has been taking longer to obtain the DD-214 needed for claims to be processed. This has extended the length of time to close-out cases. Francine noted that they are being creative in their approach to obtaining the form. Even thought it is taking longer, their services have not decreased.
    - x. Rick Pollard will be starting on Thursday. He has military background and will be trained as a Veteran Services Officer.
