







# INSTANCE OF THE SAME OF THE SA

### **ENGINE**

Engine – Get water to the fire

Pump that will flow 1000-2000 gallons per minute (GPM) Tank with capacities of 500-1000 gallons
Some will have a foam cell/tank
Minimal ladders
Supply line, 3", 4" or 5"
Attack lines normally 1 ¾", 2" and 2 ½"
Other small tools and appliances





### **Engine/Tanker and Tanker**



Bring the water!

1500-3500+ gallon tanks
Pumps and discharge chutes and minimal hose

Engine/tankers meet engine company and tanker specifications

Elevated master streams

Search & Rescue Salvage & Overhaul

100' reach
Towers have a "bucket" at
the end of the ladder

All carry a large compliment of ground ladders of varied length

### **EMS Units**





Will be referred to as an ambulance, medic or paramedic. This is defined by the equipment and training level of the crew. Most are equipped at the paramedic level, but may be staffed differently, depends on availability of volunteers and paid staffing levels.





# **Unit Radio Designations**

- Engines are numbered first and/or second number is the station number. The last number can end in 1-4.
  - Engine 101 = station 10 (New Windsor) and the 1 designates it as an engine
  - Engine 23 = station 2 (Hampstead) and the 3 designates it as an engine
  - Engine/Tanker 84 = station 8 (Union Bridge) and the 4 designates it as an engine/tanker
- Brush units, the last numbers are 5 and 6
  - Brush 15 = station 1 (Mt. Airy) and the 5 designates a brush unit
  - Brush 125 = station 12 (Sykesville) and the 5 designates a brush unit
- Rescues, Rescue Squads, Ladder, Trucks, Towers and Tankers just use the station number

Rescue 5 = station 5 (Taneytown)Truck 2 = station 2 (Hampstead)

Rescue Squad 8 = station 8 (Union Bridge)
 Tower 12 = station 12 (Sykesville)

Ladder 5 = station 5 (Taneytown)Tanker 6 = station 6 (Pleasant Valley)

- Ambulances, Medic and Paramedic units first and/or second number is the station number. The last number can end in 7-9.
  - Ambulance 99 = station 9 (Reese)Medic 37 = station 3 (Westminster)
  - Paramedic 149 = station 14 (Winfield)
- Utility, Chief, ATV, Car are all just the station number.
  - ATV 4 = station 4 (Manchester)Utility 7 = station 7 (Lineboro)
  - Car 9 = station 9 (Reese)Chief 3 = station 3 (Westminster)
