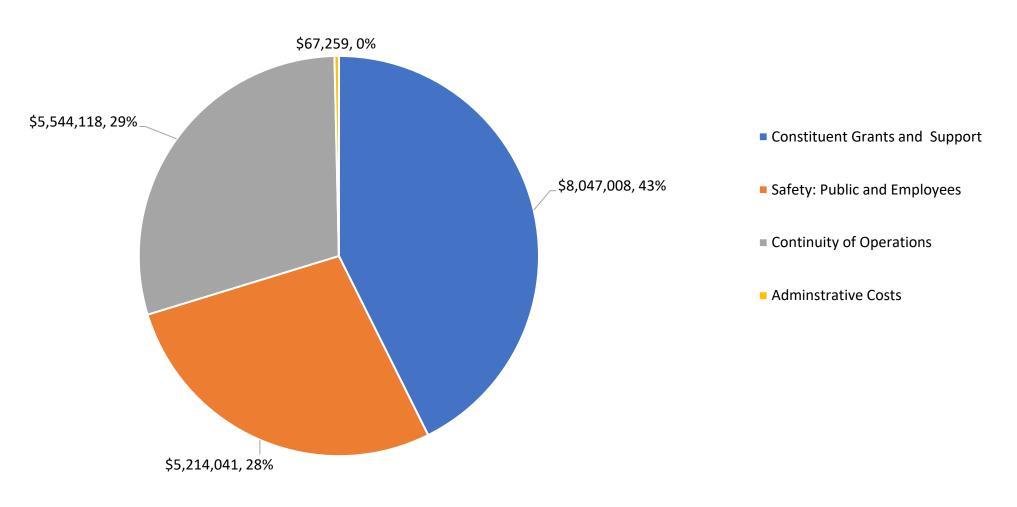

## Coronavirus Relief Fund (CRF) Ended 12/31/21 Final Expenditures: \$18,872,425



#### State and Local Fiscal Recovery Fund (FRF) Overview

Direct Federal Award: \$32,718,855

Released in 2 allocations (May 2021 and May 2022)

Grant Period: 3/11/21 – 12/31/26 (with funding obligated by 12/31/24)

The grant is intended to assist the county:

- respond to COVID-19
- stimulate the local economy
- support long-term recovery

#### **FRF Final Rule**

- Public Health Emergency
  - Emphasis on proportional response
  - Focus on those most impacted
  - Increased requirements for capital projects
- Broadband
  - Maintained commitment to terrestrial service, 100 Mbps up/down
  - Require affordable option for low to moderate income HHs
- Water, Wastewater, Stormwater projects
  - Expanded project types
- Lost Revenue
  - Automatic \$10M

#### **Lost Revenue Allowance of \$10M**

- Does not add to total allocation
- All projects can still be FRF Eligible
- Allows use of up to \$10M for general government expenses
- Provides flexibility at end of grant
