Behavioral Health RFP

- 4 responsive projects from County nonprofits
- Projects will increase access for:
 - Crisis Services
 - Walk-in Services
 - Re-entry Services
 - Peer Support and Case Management Services
- Each project will provide service through 2024 or 30 months
- Total Funding Request \$3.4M
 - \$1.5M is allocated
 - \$1.9M needed to fully fund all projects
