Upper Monocacy River Municipal Planting Roberts Mill Park, City of Taneytown

The Upper Monocacy watershed is located in the northwestern corner of Carroll County. The watershed drains to the Potomac River basin, which is a tributary to the Chesapeake Bay. The benefits of creating these stream buffers are numerous; trees along the stream provide habitat, filter runoff, and regulate stream temperature by providing shade.

Roberts Mill Park is located on the east side of Taneytown near the intersection of Stumptown Road and Kenan Way. The planting area was a grass field that was mowed regularly. This particular planting resulted in the reforestation of **0.4 acres**. A total of 121 trees were planted. Funding for this planting was covered by the Governor's Challenge grant.
