Stormwater Workshop to be Held for Hampstead and Manchester Residents

Tuesday, August 6, 2019 – The Carroll County <u>Environmental Advisory Council</u> (EAC) is partnering with the Carroll County <u>Water Resource Coordination Council</u> and County and municipal staff to host a free public workshop on Saturday, September 7, 2019.
