Effective February 5th, 2025, the Carhartt Rain Defender Job Shirt will be approved for purchase by employees from approved vendors and on-duty wear. These Carhartt job shirts must meet embroidery guidelines, model, and color requirements that will be defined below. Approved vendors will be provided with this information to reiterate what is required. All other hoodies and/or non-conforming embroidery are not authorized for use.

Embroidery Guidelines:

- All thread colors are indicated by Medeira Polyneon Thread Code
- Left Chest: 3.5" x 3.5" inch DFEMS logo; centered ½" above horizontal seam



Note: Embroidery logo (above) is not the same as the Department's official digital logo/patch.

Approved Colors: Red – 1781 Radish; Gold – 1939 Peanut Brittle; Navy – 1643
Navy; White – 1801 Super White; Yellow (MD Flag) - 1971 Saffron; Horse/Wagon - 1927 Shiny Penny; Black – 1800 Emerald Black

• **Right Chest:** Rank and First Initial, Last Name; centered ½" above horizontal seam. Example:

Fire EMS Chief M. Robinson

- Thread Color:
 - Captain; Assistant Chief; Deputy Chief; Fire EMS Chief
 - Gold 1939 Peanut Brittle
 - Lieutenant
 - Silver 1812 Cement
 - Firefighter/EMT; FADO; Paramedic; Firefighter/Medic
 - Red 1781 Radish
- o **Top Line:** Rank as written below:
 - Assistant Chief; Deputy Chief; Fire EMS Chief
 - Lieutenant; Captain
 - Firefighter/EMT; FADO; Paramedic; Firefighter/Medic
 - Note: "Firefighter/Medic" is utilized to shorten embroidery length, not indicating a difference between medic or paramedic.
- o **Font:** ½" Times New Roman

New purchases of embroidered uniform items are required to meet these embroidery guidelines. Items that are determined to be non-conforming at the time of purchase, will not be allowed to be worn.
