Subject: 2024 Lieutenants Promotional Process

The department will conduct the promotional process for Station Lieutenant in December. The position has been posted by personnel along with an accompanying email sent to all DFEMS employees on 11/18/2024.

The application period for Lieutenant is now open and will close on December 2, 2024. The schedule for the process is as follows:

- August 20, 2024 Notice of study material sent to all members
- November 18, 2024 Application period open
- December 2, 2024 Application period closes at 1700 hrs.
- December 9, 2024- Written Exam (Time & location will be sent to qualified applicants)
- Week of December 16th Oral Interviews, Simulation Lab and Written Assignment

Members who are currently completing the Fire Officer I program will be permitted to take the written exam if they submit their passing course completion report to Chief Brothers for verification by December 2, 2024. Those members must be able to meet and will be required to hold Pro-Board certification prior to promotion.

Members on C Shift (December 9, 2024) may submit leave requests from 0700-1300hrs to take the exam. Please add to the note section in VTI "Lieutenants Exam".
