They discussed the possibility of overseeing the building of a spec building that could be available for purchase, perhaps at the North Carroll Business Park. They asked Mr. Bowersox to see if this scenario would be of interest to this prospect.

b. Sue Chambers noted the Board's interest in a new project and brought the Dulaney property up for discussion. The Board noted the difficulty in developing the property due to the process required under an Employment Campus Zone. Ms. Sunderland discussed two options that might allow the IDA to move forward. She would like to speak with the Planning Department about these options and report back to the Board.
