Park Rules & Regulations

Park Hours

Unless otherwise indicated, all Carroll County Parks are open from sunrise to sunset.

Daily Fees

With the exception of Piney Run Park and Hap Baker Firearms Facility, or during special events and festivals, Carroll County Parks do not charge entry fees. Piney Run Park charges a daily visit, boat launch, and rental fees. Both South Carroll Dog Park and Bennett Cerf Dog Park have membership fees for access to the dog parks.

Reservation of Park Facilities

A wide variety of park facilities, such as pavilions and athletic fields, are available for reserved use. If you would like to reserve any park facility, contact the Department at 410-386-2103, email ccrec@carrollcountymd.gov, or visit ccrecpark.org.

Park Rules & Restrictions

- Dogs are welcome at county parks, but must be kept on a leash at all times. The only approved off-leash areas are located at Bennett Cerf Dog Park and South Carroll Dog Park (memberships are required). Remember to clean up after your pet at all parks.
- · Parking is permitted in designated areas only.
- · Feeding or harassing wildlife is prohibited.
- Consistent with our goal of supporting a strong, healthy community and natural environment, Carroll County Parks are tobacco-free facilities, including vapes. We thank you for your voluntary cooperation.
