1. A base burglar may be utilized once per inning. Base burglar must be declared prior to game. If the runner's turn at bat occurs while they are on base, an out is declared on base and player gets their at bat. If the base burglar has been used in that inning, a courtesy runner (last batted out) may be used at the discretion of the umpire.
2. There will be no base bandit.
3. There will be no stealing.
4. Any bat that passes 220 psi or above on the Sports Complex compression tester will be legal in our leagues.
 - a. No senior or fast pitch bats are permitted in this league.
 - b. Any bat that initially fails on the tester will be rotated and tested two (2) more times. After three failed tests, a red sticker will be placed on it rendering it illegal for league use.
 - c. Any player caught using an untested bat or a bat that has failed will be subject to ejection and suspension.
5. You may bat up to five EP/EH.
6. Home Run rules will be as follows:
 - a. 7 home runs (over the fence) then OUTS. After all home runs are used the declared home run hitter may homer. If he walks, then the home run at bat carries to subsequent batters for the remainder of that inning.

All Carroll County Sports Complex adult softball leagues will be governed by the 2026 Edition Independent Sports Association (ISA) Official Adult Slow Pitch Rule Book, with the following Men's League exceptions:

1. A base burglar may be utilized once per inning. Base burglar must be declared prior to game. If the runner's turn at bat occurs while they are on base, an out is declared on base and player gets their at bat. If the base burglar has been used in that inning, a courtesy runner (last batted out) may be used at the discretion of the umpire.
2. There will be no base bandit.
3. There will be no stealing.
4. Any bat that passes 220 psi or above on the Sports Complex compression tester will be legal in our leagues.
 - a. No senior or fast pitch bats are permitted in this league.
 - b. Any bat that initially fails on the tester will be rotated and tested two (2) more times. After three failed tests, a red sticker will be placed on it rendering it illegal for league use.
 - c. Any player caught using an untested bat or a bat that has failed will be subject to ejection and suspension.
5. You may bat up to five EP/EH.
6. Home Run rules will be as follows:
 - a. 7 home runs (over the fence) then OUTS. After all home runs are used the declared home run hitter may homer. If he walks, then the home run at bat carries to subsequent batters for the remainder of that inning.
7. One (1) courtesy foul with two (2) strikes.
8. Protest fee is \$150 and must be in writing to the Complex Manager. Fee is returned if the protest is upheld.
9. Masks are required for pitchers.
10. No inning will start after 55 minutes.
11. Players must sign their Team Waiver form BEFORE participating. Sports Complex Manager or their designee reserves the right to deny any player eligibility. Team Manager must e-mail any roster additions to Sports Complex Manager for approval prior to their participation.
 - a. Players can only play on one team in each division/league and must have signed that team's Roster Waiver form prior to participation; NO player is eligible to fill in for any other teams in the same league.
