



## **Roberts Field Restoration**

#### Location

Roberts Field Wet Pond is a wet facility constructed in 1987 located at the intersection of North Woods Trail and Boxwood Drive. The drainage area to this facility is approximately 46 acres, of which almost 22 acres are impervious. The facility is considered a community amenity; however, the open water provides a thermal impact to the receiving stream. Additionally, the embankment of the facility presents a potential hazard to the infrastructure below it.

### **Description**

This project proposes the construction of an innovative wet pond/submerged gravel wetland facility and the creation of 877 linear feet of stream channel. By designing a hybrid system, water quality can be achieved both in a standing wet pool as well as the active volume above the outlet control. Thermal impacts can be mitigated by discharging through the submerged gravel wetland.
