EMERGENCY EVACUATION - Checklist

I/C determines to Evacuate Time: _____

Make fireground announcements:

1 "Command to all units, on the fireground, EVACUATE THE BUILDING IMMEDIATELY, and stand by for a PAR. Command to Carroll sound the evacuation tones."

2 Dispatch announces the Evacuation Tone and Order:
"Carroll to all units operating on Box Alarm XX-XX,
EVACUATE THE STRUCTURE IMMEDIATELY, EVACUATE THE STRUCTURE IMMEDIATELY."

- Get Exit Reports from OIC's/Division/Group Supervisors
- Conduct a PAR Check, confirming all units are out of the structure and accounted for.
- Declare a Mayday for any unaccounted for members
- I/C determines the new strategy
- Command Announces "Command to all units, all units are PAR, We are operating in the _____ mode."**

TACTICAL WITHDRAWL - Checklist

I/C determines to Initiate Withdrawl Time: _____

Make fireground announcements:

1 "Command to Carroll give me an ALERT TONE"

2 "Command to all units, on the fireground, Tactical withdrawal from the structure - All units, Tactical Withdrawl from the structure."

- Verify with all OIC/Division/Groups effected that the Tactical Withdrawl was received and units are withdrawing.
- Continue to evaluate Withdrawl vs. Evacuation
- Get Exit Reports from OIC's/Division/Group Supervisors
- Conduct a PAR Check, confirming all units are out of the structure and accounted for.
- Declare a Mayday for any unaccounted for members
- I/C determines the new strategy
- Command Announces "Command to all units, all units are PAR, We are operating in the _____ mode."**
