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### C. TYPICAL SECTION

- Driveway name shown.
- Profile Grade Line (PGL) labeled.
- Paving section labeled and meets minimum County guidelines.
- Paving width and cross slopes labeled.
- Existing paving shown and labeled.
- SWM wide shoulder shown and labeled.
- Easement width shown.
- Treatment of grades to tie in to existing ground shown.

### D. PROFILE

- Profile grade shown and labeled PGL.
- Intersecting street name and elevation shown.
- Vertical curve control points labeled including PVC, PVT, and PVI.
- Data block for vertical curves including VC Length, PVI station, PVI elevation, and design K.
- Grades meet minimum and maximum gradient requirements.
- Tangent percent of grade shown to two decimal places.
- Stationing at 50 feet minimum intervals.
- Existing ground elevations shown at 50 feet minimum intervals on left side of station line.
- Proposed grade elevations shown at 50 feet minimum intervals on right side of station line.

### E. CROSS SECTIONS

When required by review staff, cross sections are to be drawn at 1"=10' vertical and 1"=10' horizontal scale. Sections drawn shall be at every even 50 foot centerline station, and where specified.
