Prizes (Cabela's Gift Cards)

1. **1st Prize:** \$300
2. **2nd Prize:** \$150
3. **3rd Prize:** \$50

General Rules and Regulations (100 Yards Only)

1. The competition will take place **April 1, 2026 through June 30, 2026**.
2. Competition shooting will occur each Wednesday and Thursday during regular business hours.
3. The cost is **\$5 per paper target (cash only)**, with a maximum of **four targets per person per session**
4. Failure to follow competition rules or general range rules of the Hap Baker Firearms Facility will result in your target not being scored and forfeiture of the \$5 per target fee.
5. The range has 10 lanes, and participation is **first come, first served**.
6. If you cannot shoot by the end of the day, you may keep your clean target and return on another eligible competition day within the contest dates.
7. Shooting will be conducted using an official National Rifle Association Smallbore Rifle Training Target (TQ-4, 100-yard target).
8. Targets must include the shooter's **full name, phone number, and email address** (must be legible). Targets missing this information will not be scored.

Equipment Requirements

1. **Rifle Weight**
 - Rifles may not exceed **7.5 pounds (7 pounds, 8 ounces)**.
2. **Approved Firearm Actions**
 - Permitted actions include:
 - Bolt action
 - Single shot
 - Semi-automatic
 - Lever action
 - Straight pull action
3. **Sights**
 - Allowed sighting systems include:
 - Scope
 - Open sights
 - Red dot sights

Shooting Positions and Supports

1. Shooting Positions
 - Freehand from the shooting bench, or
 - Seated at the bench
 - **Sandbags are the only permitted rifle support**, and may be used on the forearm only
 - No rear support devices are permitted

- No rest devices other than sandbags are allowed

Shooting Procedures

1. Contest shots will occur at the end of each cease fire until closing. Shooting line time may be limited due to overcrowding.
 2. Only one cartridge may be present at the shooting station unless shooting multiple targets.
 3. Participants will have one minute per shot per target, with all shooters starting simultaneously.
 4. After taking your shot, you must flag your chamber and step away from the shooting bench.
 5. Only **one shot per target** is permitted. If a target is shot more than once, it will not be scored.
 6. Missing the target results in **no reshoot opportunity (NO EXCEPTIONS)**.
 7. Misfires:
 - Shooters may eject the round and attempt a second shot after one misfire.
 - A second misfire will result in **no additional attempts**.

Ammunition Rules

1. Shooters may use ammunition of their choice.

Scoring

1. Targets will be scored using an Eagle Eye scoring device by **two judges (non-Hap Baker Firearms Facility employees)**.
 2. Targets will be retained by judges for scoring, but shooters may photograph their targets.
 3. Tie Breakers:
 - a. If first or second place results in a tie, competitors will participate in a single-shot shoot-off.
 - b. The shot closest to the center will determine the winner.

Contest Winners

1. Winners will be contacted using the phone number and email address provided.
 2. Winners must claim prizes within **30 days of notification**.
 3. If prizes are not claimed within 30 days, the next eligible winner will be contacted.

Employee Eligibility
